



Managing Pets with Dental Disease

Dental disease can be a problem in pets as young as 2 years of age. It affects up to 80% of pets over the age of 3, though becomes more common as a pet gets older. If left untreated, the bacteria and toxins present in the mouth can enter the blood stream and affect vital organs, causing serious illness including heart and kidney disease.




